Project Description: Women are an integral part of society. Currently there is a lack of participation of women in leadership positions even though women make up for nearly half of the local population. This project would educate women to be organizers and leaders in their community. They will be educated on their local economy, politics, education, health, nutrition, and human rights. They will be taught about corruption and how to lead against it. The trainings are organized as a way to spread good values, and important knowledge through women leaders to the rest of society. These leaders will empower the people who live in their villages. Thus, improving the conditions of future generations.

The leadership trainings will include lectures, daily reviews, group discussions, role playing activities, and follow-up plans as well as post-training testing.

Benefits:

- The women will be empowered leaders of change.
- Women leaders will become rolemodels to others, further improving the conditions of the community.
- The program will allow a safe space for discussion regarding the issue of violence against women and children.
- The women and community will receive good governance principles and knowledge to resist corruption.
