Thanks to your generous donation and support The Clean Water Project in the community of San Juan Bautista in the Lambayeque Region of Peru has been implemented as of February 2018. The project is anticipated to be fully completed by May 2018.



Project Summary To Date:

This project was requested in 2015 to provide purified water for children under the age of 5 years old within the community of San Juan Bautista in the Lambayeque Region of Peru.

When individuals, especially children, do not have access to clean water they are impacted negatively in regards to their healthy in several ways. Consumption of contaminated water can result in digestive or respiratory illness and or disease. Lack of water consumption can also lead to dehydration that can impact the body's overall functioning. In general lack of access to clean water can impact a child's quality of life and have negative consequences that impact growth and development of the children within the community.



The funds from this project allowed for the community of San Juan Bautista to purchase 25 water purifiers including transportation costs. The funds from this project also included the materials needed to facilitate workshops within the community to teach community members how to maintain the water purifiers over time once they are installed.

The final results of the project and the impact on the community will be shared in a later report once the project is completed which has an anticipated completion date of 2018.
